Wristband and Food Ticket Sales

- Gator Gala activities are for kids 5th grade and younger and require a wristband for participation. (Ages 2 and under are free!)
- Presale wristband and food ticket orders can be picked up in front of the school on:

 - Thursday June 1st, 3:30 4:00pm and at the sales table beginning at 5:30pm
- Wristbands and Food Tickets are NOT available in the school office!!!
- If you didn't order wristband and food tickets ahead of time, they will be available for purchase beginning at 5:30 p.m. on June 1st at the sales table.
- Reminder: Kids 6th grade and up cannot play games, cannot win prizes and cannot attend.
- The cost of a wristband at the door is \$15.00. This includes 2 hours of game-play!

Parking at Thornton Creek

- Carpool and/or walk / bike where at all possible.
- There is <u>no parking in the loop</u> in front of the school. This area must be kept open for emergency vehicles.


Admittance Policy
